The home has several structural and mechanical problems. A leaking roof, no heat, a deteriorated foundation, rotten roof eaves, and rotten windows are just a few items from a long list of deficiencies. After assessing the extensive amount of repairs needed to the current structure, we have realized that it is probably more feasible to demolish the home and build a new home that is more energy efficient. Mr. Murphey lives on a fixed income and a smaller, more energy efficient home would be much more affordable for him to live in and maintain.

Jimmy Murphey is a kind hearted, selfless man who has always put the needs of others ahead of his own. He has always wanted to do something to make a difference in the lives of other people. He needs help, but can not bring it upon himself to ask for anything.
